- USAW Cards:** Every wrestler must either appear on an IKWF roster or bring in their USAW card to compete. Coaches must show card and sign-in to receive wrist band.
- Entry Fee:** \$20.00 pre-registration only on TrackWrestling.com by midnight February 9th.
Strict limit of the first 600 entries. NO WALK-INS OR MAIL-INS Will be Accepted
- Weigh Ins:** 6:30-8:00AM **6&U, 7&8 and 9&10** (11&12 and 13&14 may weigh-in also)
11:30-12:30PM **11&12 and 13&14**
Please contact wrestling@littlepanthers.com to arrange a satellite weigh-in for large teams traveling 50+ miles.

Tourney Begins: 9:00 AM for 6&U, 7&8 and 9&10 Divisions
1:30PM (approximately) for 11&12 and 13&14 Divisions

Divisions: 6 & under, 7 & 8, 9 & 10, 11 & 12, 13 & 14 - **No HS Wrestlers.**

Format: 6&U and 7&8 (wrestling on half mats – three 1 minute periods)
4 Man Round-Robin, blocked by weight



9&10 (Wrestling on half mats – three 1 minute periods)
8-Man with Wrestle Back to 3rd place, blocked by weight
4/6-Man round robins will be used when weight difference is too much

11&12 and 13&14 (Wrestling on full mats – three 1 minute periods)
8-Man with Wrestle Back to 3rd place, blocked by weight
4/6-Man round robins will be used when weight difference is too much

Awards: Trophies for 1st – 3rd place and Medal for 4th place.

Team Trophy for the top six team scores.

Admission Fee: \$4 per person or \$6 per family.

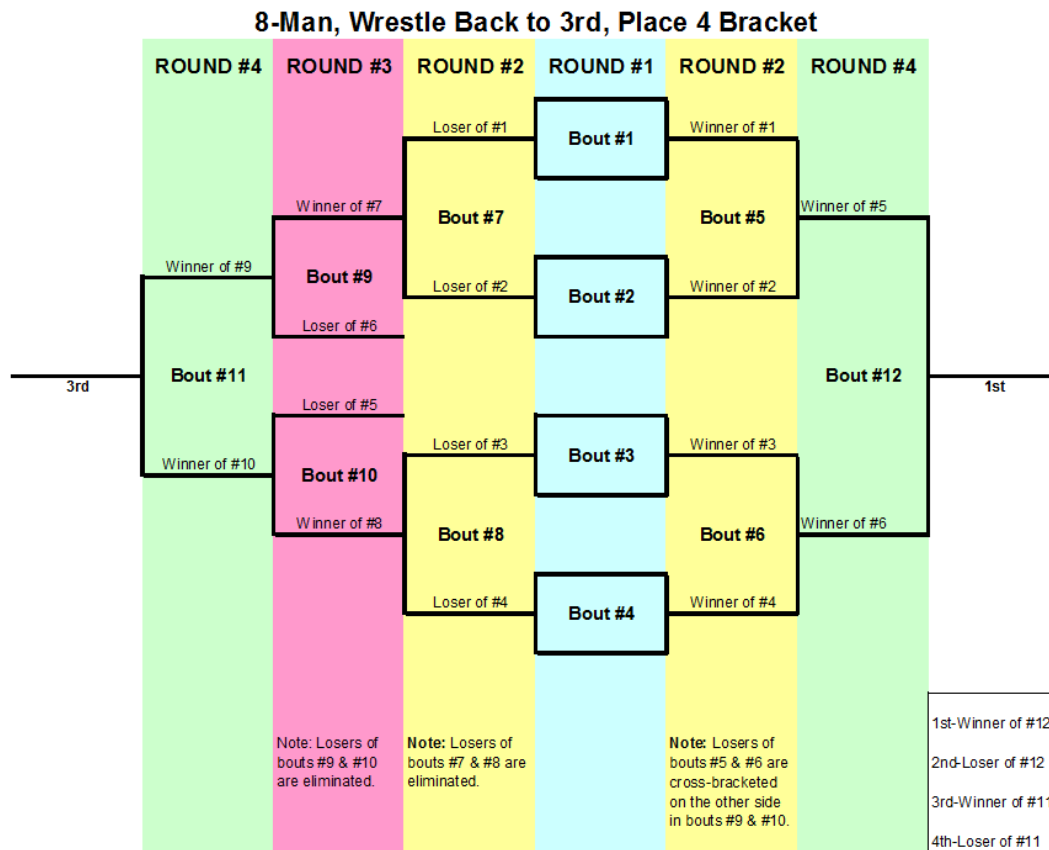
Food: Concessions available all day. Water & snacks will be available to coaches only.

Below is a sample bracket that will be used for the 9&10, 11&12, and 13&14 divisions (no 5/6th place match). We will also use 6-Man Round Robin, 4-Man Round Robin, and 2-Man, Best of Three brackets where there is too much weight difference.



Due to the fact that we use 8-Man, Wrestle Back to 3rd (4 rounds) and 6-Man Round Robin (5 rounds) brackets, this tournament has run long in the past. We have split the tournament, added mats and referees, and reduced the number of entrees to speed up your wrestling experience.

This has become one of the toughest tournaments in the region with wrestlers coming from several different states to include AR, GA, IA, IL, IN, KY, MO, OH, OK, PA and TN. Last year we had over 600 kids register and over a third of those kids were from out of state. We expect to max out at 600 wrestlers again this year.

Don't forget that we offer a team trophy to the top 6 team scores (1st place is 6 feet tall). **New this year:** The top 12 scorers from each team will automatically count towards the team's score (no more selecting your scoring roster). Team scores will be calculated at the end of the tournament.

IKWF bylaws require IKWF sanctioned tournaments to verify both wrestlers and coaches USAW membership to participate. All Illinois wrestlers must appear on the IKWF website and out of state wrestlers must have their USAW cards available in case what is entered into TrackWrestling does not pass the automatic check. All coaches must sign-in with their USAW card to receive a wristband that will allow them on the mats.
